APRIL 23, 2015

This issue is an updated index of the bills we have reported to date in Legislative Report that are still active and the status of those bills as of April 21, the First House Passage deadline for non-exempt bills. The next deadline for bills is May 15, when they must be out of committee in the second house.

Please Note:

Bills may qualify as “exempt” from deadlines because they are: (1) appropriation bills, (2) tax or fee bills, or (3) bills with a fiscal impact. In almost all of these cases those bills will be referred to the money committee of the house of origin (Assembly Ways and Means or Senate Finance). They will be acted upon at such time as sufficient revenue information is available. Other bills which do not follow the deadline rules include study committees, Constitutional amendments and bills dealing with Legislative issues.

This next Legislative deadline is May 15, at which time bills must be passed out of Committee in the second house.
